

APOSTLE CHRISTINE LIDDELL



Apostle Christine Liddell was saved at the early tender age of seven years old. The Lord began to deal with her early in life concerning ministry. Being yielded to the call of God on her life, she became a consistent student of the Word and studied at Moody Bible Institute. She later received an Honorary Doctorate Degree in Theology from The Truth for Living Bible College, Jacksonville, Florida.

Some of her early years in ministry began under the leadership of the late Apostle Richard D. Henton, Pastor of the Monument of Faith Evangelistic Church in Chicago, Illinois. Apostle Liddell's exceptional leadership skills, teaching experience, and evangelistic abilities were recognized, and she was given leadership responsibility and the oversight of the Youth and Young Adult Department at Monument of Faith.

It was while carrying out the work of the ministry at Monument of Faith that she was afforded the opportunity to meet and travel with the renowned Evangelist, Ernestine Cleveland Reems, Pastor of Center of Hope Church in Oakland, California. The two would travel extensively together throughout the United States and abroad sharing the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

In obedience to God's leading, Apostle Liddell moved from Chicago, Illinois to Oakland, California to serve under the leadership of the late Ernestine Cleveland-Reems. During her years of untiring and devoted service to Pastor Reems, and the Center of Hope Community Church, Apostle Liddell demonstrated her unparalleled and unique God-given gifts. Acclaimed as one of the most effective church administrators in the United States. Apostle Liddell was instrumental in helping to establish Center of Hope Community Church as a viable Christian entity in both spiritual and business arenas. She served as President of Hope Senior Housing Corporation (a low-income live-in housing facility for seniors); Secretary of Hope Housing Development Corporation (a transitional housing program and facility that specifically addressed the needs of homeless women with children). In addition to those responsibilities, she was the Chief Executive Director for E.C. Reems Women's International Ministries (ECRWIM) for over twelve years. At Apostle Liddell's direction ECRWIM became one of the fastest growing Women's Conference Ministries throughout the country while several other Women's Ministries were being inspired/birthered through ECRWIM.

In March of 2000, Apostle Liddell was led by God to establish Power For Living Ministries (PFLM) Church in Antioch/Brentwood, California. The vision for Power For Living Ministries was to "Educate, Empower and Equip communities for successful living through the principles found in Word of God and a personal relationship with Jesus Christ". Driven by her passion to obey God and her burning desire to see souls saved, the primary focus of all ministries at PFLM was evangelism. At Power For Living Ministries she was the Senior Pastor, President/CEO of Power For Living Charities (PFLC) and Kingdom Dominion Fellowship International in Brentwood, CA where she functioned in the five-fold ministry as apostle, prophet, evangelist, pastor and teacher.

As Apostle Liddell yielded to the call of God in her life, obeyed Him while working in ministry in the many roles He prepared her for; and preached the Gospel nationally and internationally on six continents, she officially retired as Pastor of Power For Living Ministries and from full-time ministry on March 1, 2020. She has since relocated to Indiana to be closer to her immediate family members.

Yet, she has not stopped! She has established the Christine Liddell Women and Girls Foundation where she continues to work in ministry as the Lord leads. She continues light travels and is in the process of writing books.
