



Diane J. Robinson, Bishop and Apostle, Sr. Pastor

In 2002, Peter and Diane Robinson co-founded Liberty Church International, in Fremont, CA. The mission statement for the church, is “*Reaching the unreached, teaching the untaught, bringing the unbrought and going where they are.*” In 2016, the Robinson’s co-founded the All Nations Apostleship Network of Ministries (ANANM), providing oversight with emphasis on apostolic church planting, prophetic ministry, deliverance ministry, promoting the equality of men and women, and celebrating their various roles in the Body of Christ. Our Mission is to bring about the obedience of faith for the sake of Jesus’ name among all the nations by establishing a network of apostolic ministries who are committed to the apostolic commission.

Diane was born in Oakland, CA, the youngest of four children, to the late William and National Evangelist Williette Means, who were a dynamic evangelistic team very instrumental in the early development and growth of Mingleton Temple C.O.G.I.C. Diane & Peter married in 1976. They have three married sons, Benjamin, and his wife, Sunhee (Pastors, Lineage Church, El Cerrito, CA), Joshua and his wife, Ruth (Pastors, Christ Our Shepherd, and The Capital Center Good Hope Church, Washington, D.C.), Charles and his wife, Sara (Worship Team Member, First Assembly Church, Enterprise, AL.), and one daughter, Melodie and her husband Emmanuel, Oakland, CA. They also have eight grandchildren. The Robinson family is actively involved in world-wide missions, inner-city missions, and prison ministries.

Passionate about prison ministries, she is currently the Contractor Owner/CEO of Liberty Vision Ministries Chaplaincy (subsidiary of Liberty Church International), providing chaplaincy services for the Alameda County Sheriff’s Office at Santa Rita Jail with a staff of 12 people. She has led ministry teams in Valley State Prison, Chowchilla, CA, Deuel Vocational Institution, Tracy, CA, Juvenile Justice Center/Camp Sweeney, San Leandro, CA, and the Federal Corrections Institution, Dublin, CA (2019 Kairos Retreat, participant). Many inmates have been saved, baptized in the Holy Spirit, healed, and delivered from demonic possession through her prison ministry. Diane has also served as a volunteer chaplain at Washington Hospital, Fremont, CA, and as an assistant writer to Dr. Corinthia Ridgley-Boone, at the Capital Regional National Day of Prayer, first Thursday in May, Washington, DC, West Lawn of the Capitol Building.

Liberty Church International credentialed Diane consecrating her as Bishop and Apostle, on 3/9/2014, by and under the Oversight Council of Dr. Kirby Clements (and the late
